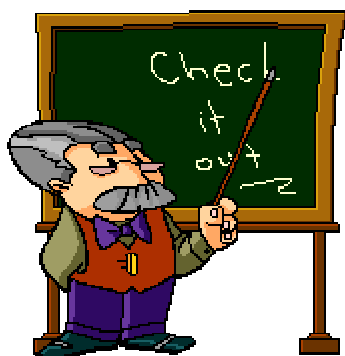


# Master Class Sessions – Lesson 11

## Play Piano By Ear – Audio Course



Hello, and welcome to Lesson 11 of my **PLAY PIANO BY EAR Master Class Sessions**. As with the previous lesson, Lesson 11 will be something that you add to your daily practice routine.

The MP3 for this lesson will consist of major and minor chords. Your job will be to distinguish the two types of chords. This is the first step to being able to name any chord that is played.

Once you have mastered the major and minor triads, you'll be ready for the more advanced 4-note dominant 7<sup>th</sup> and minor 7<sup>th</sup> chords.

## The Lesson

Unlike Lesson 10, which requires you to be at your piano or keyboard, this will be a lesson that you should permanently load into your ipod, as you can listen to these exercises in the car, while jogging or any time you're away from your keyboard.

There are 2 MP3 audio files for this lesson. The first is a listening exercise of major and minor chords. The second MP3 is the audio test where you will have to name the type of chord being played: **major** or **minor**.

**Hint:** You can take the test after your first listen to see where your ear is at in terms of being able to hear the difference between major and minor chords.

Lesson 12 will consist of major, minor and dominant 7<sup>th</sup> chords.

Lesson 13 will consist of major, minor, dominant 7<sup>th</sup>, and minor 7<sup>th</sup> chords.
